## **Puyallup School District**

### **McKinney-Vento Status ends for 2019-2020**

McKinney-Vento eligibility status is only for the current school year. Students that qualified as McKinney-Vento will be “rolled over” to the next school year at their current school attended (school of origin) in 2019-2020, or to the feeder school if moving up to junior high and high school. McKinney-Vento students will have the first 30 days of school to re-apply and re-qualify for McKinney-Vento services for the 2020-2021 school year.
