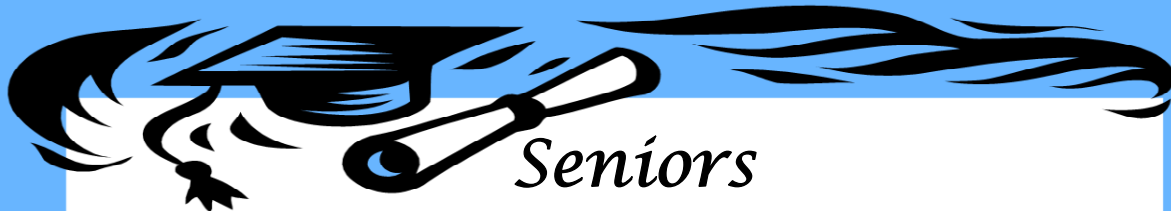


Is your child interested in playing violin?

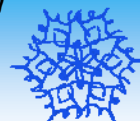
