Services for qualified M-V students last for the entire school year. Students may request services and supports at anytime during the year.—examples are listed below. If families move or find permanent housing during the school year, students may continue at their current school of attendance or move to their new school.

If you believe that you (as an unaccompanied minor) or your child has been inappropriately denied M-V services, please contact Char Krause, our district McKinney-Vento liaison who oversees M-V services, policies, and process in the Puyallup School District.
