Directions

1. **Request a Letter of Recommendation:** Ask a teacher, a mentor or a significant adult in your life to write a Letter of Recommendation for you. Allow at least two weeks for the letter to be written. Provide them with a completed Letter of Recommendation Request Form available in Counseling and on the Counseling website. Some scholarships require letters from specific people, such as an employer. A Thank You Card is appropriate when you request/receive a letter of recommendation.
2. **Review the scholarship requirements** for each scholarship to determine your eligibility.
3. **Transcripts:** You can request an unofficial copy of your transcript from Student Services. Transcripts must include first semester senior year grades.
4. **The 2021 Standard Application Form** is available online. You will find it located on the PHS Counseling & Career Center webpage under Scholarships & Awards Information. Use any computer with Adobe Acrobat Reader to complete the application. You can download Acrobat Reader for free at <http://get.adobe.com/reader>.
5. **Directions for SECTION 1:** Scholarships Selected by PHS Faculty Committee
 - Provide **one** completed copy of the standard application form and title the application "Faculty Committee Scholarships"
 - Attach a copy of your unofficial transcript
 - Attach a copy of your letter of recommendation
 - Turn in Section 1 applications to the PHS Student Services Office on or before the deadline.
6. **Directions for SECTION 2:** Scholarships Selected by the Puyallup Schools Foundation
 - Provide **one** completed copy of the standard application form and title the application "Puyallup Schools Foundation Scholarships"
 - Attach a copy of your unofficial transcript
 - Attach a copy of your letter of recommendation from a **PHS faculty member**
 - Save the completed PDF application in the following format (lastname_firstname – PSF application).

7. **Directions for SECTION 3:** Scholarships Selected by Various Donors
 - Provide **one** standard application form for **each scholarship** you are applying for and title it with the specific scholarship name i.e. Absher Construction Scholarship
 - Attach a copy of your unofficial transcript
 - Attach a copy of your letter of recommendation
 - **NOTE:** Some scholarships may require additional materials. Please follow the directions carefully.
 - Turn in Section 3 applications to the PHS Student Services Office on or before the deadline.
8. Return completed applications to the Counseling office no later than **Friday March 12th, 2021 by 12:00 PM.** Sort your scholarship applications alphabetically by scholarship title.

Helpful Tips

- ❖ All scholarships in this booklet use the Standard Application Form, unless otherwise stated, and it is permissible to make copies of your original application to use for all scholarships. Applications must be word processed.
- ❖ Some scholarship donors may request an interview. Applicants will be notified by the PHS Counseling Office staff indicating the time and location for these interviews.
- ❖ The quality of your Statement of Purpose on the Standard Application is very important. Focus on your post high school plans for education and employment.
- ❖ Puyallup High School adheres to the philosophy of recognizing as many deserving seniors as possible. Unfortunately, there are more deserving students than there are available scholarships. The attempt is made to distribute scholarships to the greatest number of applicants.
- ❖ In most cases, scholarships are not granted solely on financial need. All students in need of financial aid for college should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- ❖ Local scholarships are usually for one year only and are not renewable. Recipients of scholarships must use the money in the academic year following their graduation.
- ❖ Although the *Scholarship Booklet* generally reflects “accurate” scholarship amounts, occasionally monetary awards may be different due to donor contributions, interest earned, changes in criteria etc.
- ❖ Most scholarships are announced at the annual PHS Scholarship Reception. The SCHOLARSHIP RECEPTION will be held on *date to be determined per COVID restrictions/limitations.* *All recipients* will be asked to attend by invitation.
- ❖ Scholarship funds are mailed to the Student Accounts Office of the institution indicated on the recipient’s scholarship application. If the recipient changes his/her choice of institution or fails to enroll, please notify (immediately) the PHS Counseling Office and the scholarship donor. ***Students are to contact the scholarship donor after the award has been issued if there are any questions concerning payment.***
- ❖ Recipients will receive a card indicating the name of the scholarship and donor contact information. Recipients are expected to send a *Thank You Note* to the scholarship donor. Donors should receive this note within one week of the Scholarship Reception.
- ❖ All applicants will be considered without regard to race, color, national origin, gender or handicap.
- ✓ Read and follow all directions carefully and completely. Neatness does count, so use the online form to type your application.
- ✓ Take the most time and consideration on the essay portions of the application. Essays reveal to the scholarship committee who you are, what is important to you, and the goals you have set for yourself. Make it memorable to the reader...storytelling is key.
- ✓ Take the time to proofread for any spelling, grammar, punctuation, and other errors. It is a good idea to have another person review your application, but make sure the basic ideas and writing are your own.

Do not to wait until the last minute-- plan ahead. No applications will be accepted late.

Association of Puyallup School Principals Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a community, technical or four-year College.
Based on merit and a desire to major in an education-related field.
Priority given to students who plan to pursue an education related course of study.

Award: \$1000

Barbara & John Haynes Scholarship ++

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college or university
Must be involved in school activities (athletics, drama, music, journalism, etc)
Minimum 2.75 GPA
Requires an additional 250-500 word essay on your own parent(s) involvement in your school life and how you have benefited from their involvement.

Award: \$350

Brickhouse Bistro Scholarship

Requirements: Scholarship available to a Senior Advanced Culinary Student who has been accepted into an accredited Post-Secondary Culinary Arts Program. The recipient must be pursuing his/her career in culinary arts at a thnical or community college or university.

Award: *Number of scholarships and amount will be determined from the number of applicants and available funds.*
Minimum of 2 @ \$345

Cindy Cater Robison Scholarship ++

Requirements: Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Must be continuing their education after high school.
Must be raised in a single-parent household. Requires an additional one-page essay along with application. Financial need does not need to be a determining factor.

Award: \$600

Craig Beetham Award of Excellence

Requirements: Award recognizes a Viking debate team member who has given above and beyond what is expected to the debate team and its members. Student must have a 3.3 GPA or higher, be involved in the debate team for at least two years, be involved in community service, plan to major in education, political science, communications or pre-law.

Award: \$500

David and Wilma Williams Scholarship

Requirements: Must have a GPA indicative of success in a post-high educational setting, demonstrate good citizenship and good character.
Scholarship must be used at an accredited vocational-technical school or two year vocational program at a community college.
Program of study can not be in cosmetology or include correspondence courses.

Award: \$125

Don Hartung Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend community or four-year college.

Award: Varies

Eagles Aerie F.O.E. #2308 John Brodigan Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a community or four-year college
Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, demonstrate financial need and be a good school citizen.

Award: \$400

Erma R Narrance Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a community or four year college
Must have attended PHS for grades 10-12
Financial need, character and a good attitude will be factors in selection.

Award: \$120

Helen Alexander Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a Washington State technical, community, or four-year college.
Must plan to pursue a career related to home economics (i.e. Nutrition/Dietetics, Culinary Arts, Food Management, Apparel Design & Merchandising, Interior Design, and Child Development including Education).
Financial need will be considered.
Letter of recommendation from a teacher required.

Award: Varies

Helen Hood Flynn Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college or university.
Based on recognizable contribution to the school and/or community, academic performance, likelihood of success in college, and extracurricular activities.
Financial need will be considered

Award: 5 @ \$400

Marie Hankova-Danes Scholarship

Requirements: Must have taken three years of foreign language. Attend a technical, community or four-year college.

Award: Varies

Philip A. Johnson Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a community or four-year college. Must demonstrate financial need.
Must have shown ability and interest in athletics by having earned six letters in grades 10, 11, 12 or the recipient of the Silver Gold Award.

Award: Varies

PHS Class of 1950 Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college in Washington State.
Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
Selection will be based on character, contribution to school and community and indication of success in post secondary education.

Award: \$230

PHS Faculty Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college
Selection will be based on character, contribution to the school community and GPA.
Maintain a GPA indicative of success in post-secondary education.

Award: \$230

PHS Viking Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must have good character, GPA indicative of success in college, and have contributed to school and/or community.

Award: Varies

Sennert Rotary Foster Care Service Award Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four-year college. Should be a good citizen and intend to contribute positively to their community. Must be a student who lives in a group home or foster home or have parents who care for foster children.

Award: Varies

Stewart E. Perry Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a public (state supported) community or four-year college in Washington State. This award is based on the student's outstanding talent or interest in music (even though the student may not major or minor in music). Financial need is not a criterion.

Award: \$1350

Vera Heilman Memorial Book Award

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must have good character, satisfactory GPA, and contributed to the school/community.
Financial need will be considered.

Requirements: Must be used toward any institute of higher learning in the United States (4-year, 2-year, voc/tech, or specialized school). Minimum GPA of 3.0. Must display an aptitude for the fine arts – either visual or performance. The recipient must submit a portfolio representing his/her body work of in his/her chosen art. Must demonstrate positive involvement in his/her school and/or community/ Open to all students, regardless of financial need.

Harold O. Wilen Memorial Business Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college and major in an area of business (economics, accounting, personal finance, marketing, etc)
Must possess qualities of leadership, good character, motivation, and achievement

Award: \$1000

John Parrish Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four year college.
Must exhibit scholastic achievement, community and school involvement,
good character and good citizenship.

Award: \$2000

Joseph and Phoebe E. Kunkel Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must have an academic record that indicates potential success in college
Must display good citizenship, service to school and/or community, and good character

Award: \$1500

Louise A. Lyon Scholarship

Requirements: Available to any female student planning to attend a technical, community, or four-year college.

Must demonstrate high personal character and scholastic aptitude
Financial need will be taken into consideration.

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must have an academic record that indicates potential success in college and demonstrate
service to school and/or community.

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must demonstrate scholastic achievement, community/school involvement, and
good character

Award: \$1000

May Nelson Business Administration Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college and major in Business Administration.
Must have demonstrated potential success in college, good citizenship, and contribution
to school and/or community.

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four year college/university in Washington
State.

A student who attended Aylen for two year and PHS for three year will be selected if they stand out above the rest.
Based on merit, academics and community involvement. Preference will be given to a student pursuing a career in the sciences.

Robert J Aylen, DDS Vocational/Technical Scholarship

Requirements: Must have attended Aylen Junior High for three years, PHS for three years and will be enrolling in a vocational or technical school.
Based on merit, academics and community involvement

Stan Moe Mathematics Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a community or four-year college, preference given to applicants attending Seattle Pacific University
Must major in math, computer science, science or education
Must have taken at least three years of math in high school and show evidence of church, school or community service

Award: \$1000

Tom Brown Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four year college.
Based on merit, community involvement, and the ability to clearly articulate post-high school goals.

Award: \$1000

Vernon Hill Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college or university.
Preference given to student planning to major in and pursue a career in the field of intelligence, including international studies, foreign service, political science, CIA or FBI. If no applicant meets these criteria, then music/orchestra majors will be considered.
Must be a citizen of the United States

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four year college or university.
Based on merit, community involvement, and the ability to clearly articulate post-high school goals

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college
One recipient must major in engineering.
Based on financial need, scholarship, leadership and character.

Award: 2 @ \$500

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college.
Must plan to major in a career related to the construction industry such as construction management, architecture, structural heating and venting or electrical engineering Business is also a possible major.
Minimum 3.2 GPA, good citizenship, motivation, and achievement.

Selection: Absher Construction Company
Award: \$2000

Academic Booster Club (ABC) Scholarship for Highly Capable Students + +

Requirements: Must attend a four-year college. Must have participated in a Highly Capable program for two years of elementary school. Must have participated in PAGE (at Kalles) for 2 years. Must have a 3.85 GPA or higher. Must have taken 3 or more AP classes.
Required: Letter of recommendation from teacher or administrator focusing on academic rigor. **NOTE: *Supplemental application materials required and can be found on the PHS scholarship website***

Selection: Academic Booster Club
Award: \$500 and/or \$1000 (up to \$2000 total awarded)

Ballou Junior High PTSA Scholarship + +

Requirements: Must attend a community, technical or four-year college. Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Criteria will be based on demonstrated good character and citizenship and contribution to school and/or community. Must have attended Ballou Mr. High School for a minimum of two full school years
NOTE: *Supplemental application materials required and can be found on the PHS scholarship website*

Beatrice Barnes Memorial Medical Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a community or four-year college.
Must have the career plan of becoming a medical doctor
Award will be based on the potential for academic success, good character, leadership, and involvement in school and community

Selection: PHS Medical Science Department
Award: Varies

Bernice DeTray Memorial Music Scholarship

Requirements: Must plan to continue music education at a community, or four-year college.
Must have been involved in PHS vocal or instrumental music programs and have the potential to succeed in a post-secondary setting.
Must have good citizenship and have contributed to activities in school and community

Selection: PHS Music Department

Award: \$500

Carl Sparks Memorial Scholarship ++

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four year college
Preference given to an athlete who has or had a physical or medical condition but was able to continue participating in their sport(s).
Minimum 3.0 GPA
Must have excelled in athletics at PHS

*NOTE: *Supplemental application materials required and can be found on the PHS scholarship website**

Selection: Sparks Family

Award: \$300

Character In Life Scholarship ++

Requirements: Complete the standard application form. Submit with unofficial transcript. Must be a current senior at PHS. Must attend a community or four-year college/university. Intend to major in education, minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and letters of recommendation from non-family members.

*NOTE: *Supplemental application materials required and can be found on the PHS scholarship website**

Award: \$1000

Cornforth Campbell Carstar Automotive Scholarship ++

Requirements: Cornforth Campbell Carstar is a collision repair center located in downtown Puyallup. This scholarship is offered to students planning on attending a technical school in the fall to pursue a career in the automotive field. Candidates must have a 3.0 minimum GPA, submit a resume, one letter of recommendation and a 500-750 word essay. This scholarship will be directly applied to school tuition, proof of enrollment will be required.

Requirements: Must attend technical, community, or four-year college.
Preference given to children or relatives of Puyallup School District Child Nutrition Professionals.

Award: 1 @ \$400 and 1 @ \$300

Daffodil Valley Kiwanis Club Music Scholarship

Requirements: Must have been involved with the study of music and plan to seriously pursue a career in music education.
3.0 GPA or above
Demonstrate character, discipline, citizenship and responsibility
Scholarship may be used at a two or four year college or university.

Dan Vesey Memorial Art Scholarship

Requirements: Must have taken art classes at PHS and plan to major in a fine arts area of study at a technical, community or four-year college or university.
Must have the ability to succeed in post secondary education
Must have good citizenship and have contributed to school and community.

Award: \$100

Daryl Jackson Scholarship

Requirements: Preference given to those with 2 years of foreign language, but not required. Students interested in practicing business overseas should apply.

Selection: Daryl Jackson
Award: 2 @ \$3,000

Debbie Munson Young Artists Scholarship + +

Requirements: Special preference given to those who have been involved in community service pertaining to the arts.
Priority will be first given to the visual arts, then drama, music and dance.
NOTE: *Supplemental application materials required and can be found on the PHS scholarship website*

Ed Woodiwiss Puyallup Lions Club Memorial Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college in Washington state. Must have a satisfactory GPA, potential for success in chosen field, and financial need.

Award: \$1500

Edgemont Junior High School PTSA Scholarship

Requirements: Must have attended Edgemont JHS for at least 2 years
Minimum 2.5 GPA required
Must attend a technical, community or four year college.
Two letters of recommendation required – one academic, one non-academic.
Financial need, community service/involvement and extra curricular activities will be considered in selection.

Selection: Edgemont PTA Scholarship Committee
Award: \$500

Edgewood/Fife/Milton Kiwanis Scholarship

Requirements: Must be a resident of the Edgewood/Milton area
Must have a GPA of 2.0 or above, demonstrate financial need and good citizenship.
Must attend a vocational technical program after high school

Selection: Edgewood/Fife/Milton Kiwanis Club
Award: \$1000

Ella Marie Granquist Memorial Health Careers Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college in Washington State.
Must enroll in a health career related program.

Selection: Medical Science Department
Award: \$600

Ferrucci Junior High School PTSA Scholarship + +

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must be a Ferrucci JHS graduate, be of good character, have good attendance, and contributed to the school/community

Firgrove Elementary PTA Scholarship + +

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community, or four-year college.
Must have attended Firgrove Elementary for at least four years.
Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, good attendance and good citizenship.
Must include a cover letter highlighting interests and qualifications, and a supplemental essay covering the student's aspirations, plans for future education and career goals

Requirements: Must attend a technical, community or four-year college.
Must have attended Fruitland Elementary School at least three years.
Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, good attitude and school citizenship

Award: \$400

G.W. Edgerton School Memorial PTA Scholarship

Requirements: Must attend a technical, vocational, community or four-year college or university in the fall of the year you graduate high school. Applicants from the Class of 2015 and beyond must have attended Edgerton Elementary at least two full years. Must demonstrate the qualities of honesty, respectfulness, responsibility, and must be planning on pursuing higher education. Must have good attendance and citizenship. Financial need may be a factor. Minimum GPA is 2.5.

Award: Varies

Gertrude Stelling Wilhelmsen Girls Olympic Track and Field Scholarship

Requirements: Female who has shown exceptional talent in track and field. Preference will be given to a girl who will be participating in track and field events after high school.
